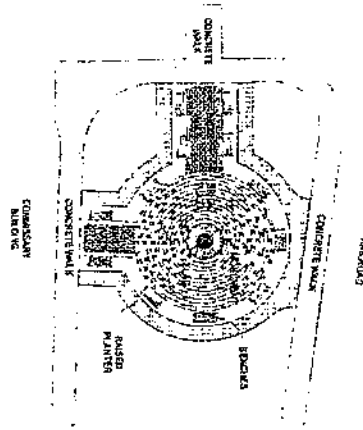

The monogrammed brick measure 4" x 8". The 3/4" lettering allows for three lines per brick with up to 14 letters including spaces per line.

There are two categories from which to choose:

Category #1 Individual Level
\$50 per brick

A present or former resident of the Tioga/Ward 10 area or one who just has a heart for Central Louisiana history

Category #2 Corporate Level
\$100 per brick

A business or organization that serves the Ward 10 area. This includes businesses who have played an important role in the history of the area.
